This week's spelling list focuses on short vowel sounds. Short vowels are marked as follows:

ă as in map

ĕ as in bed

ĭ as in pig

ŏ as in pot

ŭ as in jump

Short vowels are usually found in syllables in which a vowel is immediately preceded and followed by a consonant, a cluster of consonants (st, str, bl, etc.), or two consonants that make one sound (sh, ch, th; also called a digraph).
