An example of two letters spelling the sound of only one letter would be $/ \mathrm{mb} /$ in climb. The two letters $/ \mathrm{mb} /$ only make the $/ \mathrm{m} /$ sound.

An example of two letters standing for a completely silent sound would be /ah /in delight. The letters g and h make a completely silent sound.
