

## List 11: Silent Letters

Dear Parents,

This week's spelling list focuses on silent letters. Silent letters occur when two letters spell the sound of only one letter or when one or two letters stand for a completely silent sound.

An example of two letters spelling the sound of only one letter would be /mb/ in climb. The two letters /mb/ only make the /m/ sound.

An example of two letters standing for a completely silent sound would be /gh/ in delight. The letters g and h make a completely silent sound.
