Dear Parents,

This week's spelling list focuses on diphthongs. A diphthong is two vowel sounds that are sounded together in the same syllable. One common diphthong is the sound /ou/ in bounce.

You can make the /ou/ diphthong with:

ow if it's at the end of a word or syllable or comes before l or n

pow•der    how    owl

ou in most other words like noun, scout, and aloud.
