

List 5: Long I and Long O

Dear Parents,

This week's spelling list focuses on the long \bar{i} and \bar{o} sounds. Long vowel sounds "say" the name of the letter. For example / \bar{i} / in ice or / \bar{o} / in oat. Long vowel sounds can be made with a variety of vowels or vowel combinations (digraphs).

The long \bar{i} sound can be made in the following ways:

- i at the end of a syllable as in ti•ger or sometimes with y at the end of a word
- ie as in tied OR i-consonant-e as in pine

The long \bar{o} sound can be made in the following ways:

- o-consonant-e as in stove
- oa as in coach OR ow as in hollow
